Upon review, I have found that your FRP meets the requirements of Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 154, Subpart F. This approval will remain valid for five years from the date of this letter, unless rescinded in writing by this office.

You must operate your facility per your FRP, including ensuring that required response resources are readily available through contract or other approved means. You must keep a copy of your FRP at the marine transportation related portion of your facility, along with a copy of this approval letter. You are encouraged to keep a copy of your FRP with your facility's Operations Manual. You must review your FRP at least annually and submit any revisions to this office for review and approval per Title 33, CFR, Part 154.1065.

This plan will remain valid five years from the date of this letter. However, you should review annually and resubmit it to the Coast Guard for re-approval six months prior to the expiration as required by Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 154.1065.
